Fortress Energy Closes Third Tranche of Short Form Prospectus Financing

Fortress Energy Inc. ("Fortress" or "the Company") (TSX: FEI) is pleased to announce that it has completed a third closing of its Public Offering of a minimum of 6,666,700 Units and a maximum of 11,333,400 Units at a price of \$1.50 per Unit. An additional 1,683,300 Units were issued at this closing for gross proceeds of \$2,524,950 resulting in an aggregate of 11,033,400 Units being issued for gross proceeds of \$16,550,100 under the public offering. Each Unit is composed of one Common Share ("Common Share") in the capital of the Corporation and one-half of one Common Share purchase warrant ("Warrant"). The Warrants are exercisable on or before 5:00 p.m. (Toronto Time) on the date that is 36 months following the first closing of the Offering, subject to the right of the Company to accelerate the expiry time, on not less than 30 days prior written notice to the holders of Warrants, if the aggregate sale price of the Common Shares sold in board lots on the Toronto Stock Exchange (the "TSX") during a period of 20 consecutive days divided by the aggregate number of Common Shares sold in board lots on the TSX during such period is at least \$3.00. Each Warrant entitles the holder thereof to purchase one Common Share at an exercise price of \$2.00 per Common Share.

The Company plans to use the proceeds from the sale of the Units to reduce its working capital deficit and to fund its 2008/2009 capital program.

Canaccord Capital Corporation is acting as bookrunner for this financing.
