



SYNERGEX ACQUIRES MULTIMEDIA COMPANY 2ARTISTIC

Creative capabilities will expand with new Digital Media Services workgroup in 2006

Mississauga, Ontario (December 5, 2005) – Synergex Corporation (TSXV: SYX) (“Synergex”), a leading provider of technology-based business solutions focused on optimizing customer business processes, today announced it has purchased the assets and intellectual property portfolio of 2artistic, a company specializing in web design, multimedia project management and creative services, and the development of online marketing technologies.

“The purchase of 2artistic broadens the creative services offering that currently exists within our Creative Services unit, historically part of our core Commercial Gateway workgroup,” said David Aiello, President and CEO of Synergex. “As we noted in our third quarter results, we have experienced strong demand for digital art, printing and translation from our current customers. 2artistic has exciting intellectual property and capabilities that will allow us to advance our growth strategy of offering innovative solutions to our current and future customers.”

A new Digital Media Services workgroup will be created in early 2006. The workgroup will combine 2artistic’s business and the services provided within the Creative Services unit of Commercial Gateway. Synergex Commercial Gateway is a leading distributor of video games in the Canadian marketplace and a provider of supply-chain management and business process solutions.

Terms of the transaction, which closed today, were not disclosed. 2artistic, based in Mississauga and established in 1999, is owned by Mr. Ali Dib, who will be joining Synergex as Director of Digital Media Services. Synergex will consolidate 2artistic’s operations at its Kenway Drive location.

“I am excited about the opportunity to be a part of the Synergex team. 2artistic’s skills and online marketing technologies will be a vital part of the new Digital Media unit of Synergex Corporation,” said Mr. Dib.
