### CINCH ENERGY CORP. ANNOUNCES A 9 MMCF/D MONTNEY WELL TEST

CALGARY, May 26, 2010 - Cinch Energy Corp. ("Cinch" or the "Company") announces that it has completed and tested a Montney horizontal gas well. The Cinch operated Dawson 4-25-80-16 W6M well (82.5% working interest) was drilled earlier this year with a 1,450 meter horizontal section in section 26-80-16 W6M. The well was recently completed with eleven, 125 tonne multi-stage fracs. After a 24 hour clean up flow to recover frac fluids, the well was tested for 28 hours at gas rates over 9 mmcf/d with flowing wellhead pressures of 1,200 psi. The test was suspended once the maximum volume allowed under the flare permit was reached and the well is currently shut in with pressure recorders to allow for a build up analysis.

This excellent result demonstrates the potential for the Montney zone on Cinch's lands in the Dawson area. The Company has an average working interest of 34.5% in 26 sections with Montney rights in this area. Two additional non-operated horizontal wells have been drilled and are expected to be completed this summer. Cinch is working with its partners in the area to drill additional wells and bring the Montney gas on stream prior to the end of this year.

Cinch Energy Corp. is a junior oil and gas company with core assets in West Central Alberta and North East British Columbia. Cinch plans to grow through a combination of exploration and development drilling combined with strategic property and corporate acquisitions to become a leading intermediate sized producer.
